Cultural Institution and Internationalization (practical training)

The SOP for taking the practical training course:

1. Find a CULTURAL institution in Taiwan BY YOURSELF, wherein you want to do an internship with a specialist or expert. [Note that our Ph.D program carries no responsibility to locate an institution for you. Apart from that, the property of the chosen institution has to do with CULTURAL AFFAIRS]
2. Get approval from the director of the chosen institution.
3. Submit a brief statement/proposal to the director of the Ph.D. program, wherein you spell out the major purpose of the internship, along with the chosen institution's name, the specialist's/the supervisor's name, and the letter of approval from the institution attached.
4. Once your proposal is approved by the director of the Ph.D. program, you can start your internship right away.
5. At the end of the semester, submit a report regarding your internship to the director of the Ph.D program. The director will grade it with a PASS or NON-PASS, depending on the quality of the internship and the report. [Note that it is advisable to get your report endorsed by your internship supervisor before submission].
