8. Doctoral student evaluation : After admission, student should get a thesis advisor before the end of the first year under the approval of the departments (or graduate institutes).	If students have not found a thesis advisor before the dateline, he/she shall be suspended from school for one semester.										
9. PhD candidate qualifications : Students after the completion of the minimum length of study have successfully completed all the required courses, have earned the credits, and have completed the draft of the thesis could propose a PhD candidate qualification examination. He/she has to be evaluated by the evaluation committee and if 2/3 of the members of the committee approve, the student shall qualify.	Students who fail the PhD candidate qualification cannot propose a thesis examination. If failing the second time, students shall be expelled.										

<p>10. PhD examination (thesis examination) :</p> <p>1、 Students are required to obtain a certificate of academic ethics education before applying for a thesis examination. The qualification for the above-mentioned items shall be determined by each department (or graduate institute).</p> <p>2、 Students who have passed the PhD candidate qualification examination and completed the first draft of the thesis must complete their registration in that semester.</p> <p>After the course selection, student should submit thesis examination application at least 20 days before the thesis examination date.</p> <p>The application for the examination should be submitted twenty days before. The passing grade for thesis examination is 70.</p>	<p>Thesis examination takes up 50% of the graduation grade.</p> <p>Graduate students may obtain certificate from the website of the Taiwan Academic Ethics Education Resource Center through self-study and passing its general test. If the department (graduate institute) has its own regulations regarding the ethical education through professional academic courses, these regulations are to be complied with.</p> <p>Students who fail their thesis and are still within the maximum length of study can retake the examination in the next semester or next year. If failing the second time, students shall be expelled. If passing after retaking, students shall receive 70 as his/her grade.</p>
<p>11. Other requirements (The qualifications for graduation must meet one of the following two requirements):</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Publishing one paper in a foreign English journal, a journal of THCI CORE, or a journal of the second level (or its equivalent) or above, as ranked by the Research Institute for the Humanities and Social Sciences, National Science and Technology Council. 2. Presenting one English paper at an academic conference at home or abroad. The full paper must be reviewed and approved by the Ph.D Program's General Affairs Committee. 	<p>Notes: Use with discretion.
