Minimum Basic Research Standards for New Faculty Appointment, Promotion, and Evaluation

Approved on March 6, 2024, by the first Program Affairs Committee meeting of the second semester of the 112 academic year.

For promotion (or reappointment) to Lecturer or Assistant Professor: Total score must reach 80 points. For promotion (or reappointment) to Associate Professor: Total score must reach 90 points. For promotion (or reappointment) to Professor: Total score must reach 100 points. Standards for high-quality foreign journals and publishers will be reviewed by the Teacher Evaluation Committee.
